Attentively listening to that call, in August 1953 Leadership representatives from these communities met to form the Conference of Presentation Sisters of North America.

The Conference of Presentation Sisters, or the Conference, represents Presentation Sisters from our eight North American Congregations. These Congregations are located in Aberdeen, South Dakota; Dubuque, Iowa; (Fargo), North Dakota; St. John's, Newfoundland; New Windsor, New York; Staten Island, New York; San Francisco, California; and the United States Province of the Union, western and southern states of the US. (Fargo Presentation Sisters in July 2014 officially became part of the United States Province of the Union Province of the Union.)

The Conference exists to promote unity, to provide opportunities for on-going communal discernment and collaboration on matters of mutual interest, and to strengthen the spirit of Nano Nagle. It further serves to encourage and support the fulfilling of our mission in the Church through enhanced collaboration, connection and communion as we focus on issues of spirituality, ministry and justice.
